







QUICK GUIDE TO COMMON PLAGIARISM TYPES



Professionalism Simplified

Туре	Type of Plagiarism
The Clone	A Learner submitting word-for-word academic work of another as his / her own.
The Cut and Paste	An academic work contains significant number of UNACKNOWLEDGED quotations in it.
The Hijack	An academic work consists of hijacked ideas of some others. The key words and phrases "translated" but essentially similar or exact to the content of an unacknowledged source
Inaccurate Referencing	An academic work is referenced (inaccurately) without 1. following rules of appropriate referencing style (Harvard OSCOLA) 2. indicating relevant secondary referencing and 3. any match between in-text and end-text references
The Patchwork	An academic work accurately referenced however without 1. connective narrative 2. appropriateness, 3. relevancy 4. logical flow and 5. personal voice appropriate to the level
